

ABOUT THE SCHOOL



M.R.S. Memorial School was built in the memory of Late Shri Mulki Raj Saini, a great philanthropist, freedom fighter, member of legislative assembly. (U.P.). Member of Parliament (M.P. Dehradun Seat) The school was inaugurated by Mrs. Aradhana Shukla (H'ble D.M., Saharanpur) in the year 2001. The school started its functioning on 1st July 2001 under the management committee comprising of educationalists, retired principals and renowned social workers.


The school is situated on Saharanpur-Gangoh Road (just 3 km away from the urban population of the Saharanpur Distt.) and housed in the natural and clean, pollution free environment exactly suitable for the children's academic and co-curricular activities as well as enhancing their personality in the field of games and sports. It is well equipped with library, separate laboratories for Science, Mathematics and Social Science and with team of highly qualified teachers to impart education of high quality and moral values.

This is a senior secondary school affiliated to Central Board of Secondary Education, Delhi. The Medium of instruction is English.

AIM OF THE SCHOOL

To recognize and to encourage talent of all kinds is our aim. Since it is impossible for a school to cover the whole realm of knowledge, we have to be vigorously selective in study material presented to children and pay particular attention to –

- Stimulating intellectual curiosity.
- Directing and exercising the emotions.
- Encouraging clear thinking and discrimination of good from bad.
- Developing an interest in the process and resources of learning and in how to learn.
- Emphasizing the difference between truthfulness and falsehood and between fact and feeling.
- To enable children to acquire necessary tools and qualification to make entry into skilled occupations and professions for earning and to make them lead a respectful life in society.
- To develop in the school, a caring community exercising concern and respect for the welfare of others and emphasizing overriding importance of good human relations, based on sensitivity, tolerance, and goodwill.





FACILITIES & FEATURES

LIBRARY

The school has a well stocked library catering to the needs of students and staff. Books, reference books, magazines, news papers, journals, story books of various subjects are also available to the students and teachers. New books are added every year.



COMPUTER INFRASTRUCTURE

The school has a well-equipped and well managed computer lab and separate teachers for computer skills. We install new technology based computer software every year.



CANTEEN


The school also has a separate canteen.

ANNUAL SPORTS DAY

An annual sports day is conducted every year to provide a platform to sports lovers to show their talent in outdoor and indoor games. Certificates are also presented to recognize their performances. Selected students are recommended to participate in C.B.S.E. cluster games.

CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

M.R.S. Memorial school also organizes annual cultural programme. The students perform in various skills, speeches, debates, songs, dances, drama of many disciplines etc., according to their interests and passion.



MEDICAL FACILITIES

The school also provides medical care to the students. They are given free medical check-up every year by a renowned team of medical specialists.

HOUSE SYSTEM

In order to generate a healthy spirit of competition amongst students, the school follows a house system. There are 4 houses in the school, viz. – Gandhi House, Nehru House, Patel House and Tagore House, in which a number of competitions are organized in the field of academics, co-curricular activities, sports and games.

ASSETS OF THE SCHOOL

The school has an ultra modern newly constructed double storey building with 50 rooms including classrooms, physics, chemistry, biology laboratory, computer lab, social science lab, library, digital lab etc. The rooms are big, airy, fully lightened and cross ventilated. There are school vans serving to the needs of students and teachers from different localities. The land area of the school is 9500 square meters with a separate playground and assembly ground. Construction of an auditorium, swimming pool and race-course is under planning.

REGISTRATION & ADMISSION

Admission is open to everyone irrespective of caste, creed, sex and religion. However, the school reserves the right to admit or refuse admission to a candidate as per its own criteria of admission. Registration for Pre-Nursery L.K.G. and U.K.G. starts in the month of March every year. School prospectus along with the registration/admission form are available at the school's fee counter. Registration fee charged is non/refundable/non-adjustable in any circumstances. Admission is subject to clearance of very informal interview/chat with the child. Admission to class 1st onwards is based on entrance test which is conducted in the month of March/April (As per notified date) followed by an interview. Principal's decision shall be final and binding in this regard. Students coming from other institutions are required to bring transfer certificate (T.C.) and mark-sheet with them. It is to be noted that registration does not mean admission, which will depend on the number of vacancies at the time of admission.



ADMISSION

The school must be informed of any change of address, phone/mobile no. Rules are subject to change of the discretion of the school administration. The admission of a child will mean a complete acceptance by the parents/guardian of all the school rules in force or as amended from time to time.



ELIGIBILITY

For admission to Pre-Nursery a child must have completed the age of $2\frac{1}{2}$ (+) Year on 1st April of the year but should not have completed 4 years on the date. Original date of birth certificate must be submitted at the time of admission.



WITHDRAWAL

If a student is to be withdrawn from the school his/her parents must apply for the same in writing at least One Month In Advance. Failure to do so will result in payment of six months fees by the parents. School leaving certificate (Transfer Certificate) will be issued only when all dues will be cleared.

DISMISSAL/EXPULSION

A student can be expelled from the school on various disciplinary and other grounds like long-illness, bad conduct, irregular attendance, disobedience, use of unfair means in examination, etc. Principal's decision shall be final and binding in this regard.

Clay moulding, Greeting card making, Needle work, Painting, Soft toys making and tree plantation are some of other prominent activities of the school.


SPORTS & GAMES

STAFF

TEACHER-TAUGHT RELATIONSHIP

The relationship between the teachers and students are congenial and cordial. The teachers perform the role of a friend, philosopher and guide. The students are encouraged to discuss their problems freely with their teachers without any inhibition or hesitation. Taking teachers as their role model, the students develop a sense of responsibility, self-respect, discipline, sense of duty and manners.

PARA EDUCATION UNIT

The school has a separate Para Education Unit for Tiny Tots! Bright kids are provided a homely and congenial atmosphere & their daily needs are taken care of. The teachers are well-trained and experienced and are motherly figures for the small students. They try to teach them by using PLAY-WAY METHOD. They try to associate their teaching with the daily experiences of their students, thus making their teaching lively, effective and fruitful. Lady Peons are also attached with Para-education unit (Nursery Wing) to take great care of daily needs of tiny-tots. This wing is equipped with multimedia technique!





SCHOOL DISCIPLINE

Each student should confirm to the school rules of discipline, failing which his/her admission will be terminated. These rules are as under:

- Students should reach the school at least 15 Minutes before the Assembly time.
- They should enter and leave the school compound quietly.
- They should not fight or talk loudly while walking the corridors.
- They should obey their teachers and heed to their advices or instruction.
- They should maintain their note-books/books properly. They should cover them with brown papers with their names/class/section/school name etc. written on them.
- Note books/books are checked by the Principal regularly. If notebooks/books of any student are found to be torn, damaged, uncovered, he/she will be dealt with accordingly.
- They should stay in the school campus. They should not loiter unnecessarily in the corridor or go outside the school building.
- Students are not allowed to go home during school hours unless in exceptional cases When their parents/guardians come in person.
- Students are supposed to wish their parents, teachers and friend 'good morning' When they come to school and 'Good afternoon' while leaving school.
- They are to obey the instructions of the class monitors/perfects volunteers on duty.
- They are to keep their class-rooms/school campus neat and clean. Lunch left overs, wrappers, paper case etc, should not be thrown here and there . These must be thrown in the dustbins provided.
- No student have spoil or damage any part of the school building or furniture. Defaulters shall to pay for the loss or damage of the school property.
- A student absent in the examination is not re-examined. Absent in one or two subject involves the loss of marks for these subjects and loss of rank as well. In exceptional cases some relaxation can be given by the principal only.
- A student failing twice in same class will not be allowed to continue in the school.
- Pass percentage for promotion to next higher class will be as per CBSE rules.
- Students are not allowed to wear or bring valuable articles with them to school. The school will not be responsible for any loss.
